

## 2015 Soil and Crop Tour

**Dates:** August 24, 25, 26

**Destination:** New Liskeard/ Temiskaming Shores

**Departure:** Monday, August 24 at 8:00 AM – Leave Quality Inn Woodstock for New Liskeard. We will be travelling with Cherrey Bus Lines again this year.

**Accommodations:** The [Waterfront Inn](#) in New Liskeard for both nights. A continental breakfast is included.

### **Stops on the tour:**

- [Cobalt Mining Museum Bonus](#): First 20 people to register for the trip will be able to go on a guided underground tour of the nearby adit. The rest of the group will be at the mining museum
- Haskap Berry Demonstration site
- [New Liskeard Agricultural Research Station](#) with guided tours of horticulture, crop and beef research
- [Hills Lake MNR Fish Hatchery](#) with a guided tour. The hatchery is home to the famous *Aurora Trout*
- [Kap Kig Iwan Provincial Park](#) with a self-guided tour of waterfalls rapids and hiking trails.
- 2 farm stops – beef and cash crop
- [Thornloe Cheese Factory](#) Storefront to purchase unique food products from the North
- On Tuesday evening, a speaker from NOFIA (Northern Ontario Farm Innovation Association) will speak to us at supper about their new link with OSCIA, research issues and government programs for Northern Ontario.

**Trip Home:** On the way home, we will travel to North Bay via Québec with a stop for lunch and a visit to [Fort Temiscamingue, a National Historic Site](#). Fort Temiscamingue was a fur-trading outpost. We should arrive back in Woodstock around 8:00pm Wednesday evening.
